- Economy tripled in size
- 25 million moved into lower middle class
- 9th largest economy, Mercosur leader


Policy decissions (Furtado)

Trend 3: Global Fragmentation




Brazil's position in the new global order:

Trend 4.: Inequality & Exclusion


Inequality North to South




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Trend 5.1 Demographic Challenge

Population pyramid, 1991–2042




Aging population reshapes Brazil:

Growth for some, inequality for others.


South American Powerhouse

Savings, Savings, Savings


Role of the Savings Industry

- Support for public finances and pensions Savings industry essential for sustainable and inclusive progress.




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Gross savings by regions 1974 to 2024



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
Technical Provisions in the Latam Life insurance








